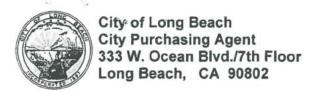

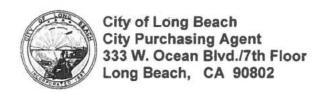

In September 2012, the Port of Long Beach was authorized to pursue sole source procurement with Harris for equipment and Future Concepts for installation for the cell network project. - 1. Definitions: In addition to the terms defined elsewhere, the following terms used herein have the following meanings:
 - a. "Agreement" means the instrument of contracting; such as a Purchase Order, or other such designation which these terms and conditions of sale for Wireless Equipment, Software and Services are incorporated.

b. "Customer" means the purchaser of Equipment, Software,

or Services from Harris.

c. "Date of Acceptance" means the date when the Customer receives an item of Equipment, Software and/or Services in an undamaged or non-defective condition.

- d. "Environmental Laws" means any law or regulation in any jurisdiction worldwide applicable to the Agreement and includes but it is not limited to the recycling or treatment of waste equipment including the laws implementing the WEEE
- e. "Equipment" means any hardware, including components, but excluding any Software or Services.
- f. "Harris" means Harris Corporation, acting through its Government Communications Systems.
- g. "Maintenance Agreement" means a separate agreement for maintenance of the Items procured hereunder; such services are not included in this Agreement.
- h. "Purchase Order" means the Customer's purchase order as acknowledged by Harris on its standard acknowledgement
- i. "Purchase Price" means the purchase price as identified in the Purchase Order.
- "Quote" means the price quotation of Harris itemizing the purchase price and all exhibits referred to within such Quote, including but not limited to the technical proposal, technical specifications, scope of work, schedule, the Agreement and any Maintenance Agreement specifically included in the purchase price.
- k. "Services" means, training, maintenance support, or other services to be provided to Customer as part of the Agreement.
- "Software" means software and firmware, including all copies provided to Customer.
- m. "WEEE Directive" means the European Union Directive on Waste Electrical Equipment and includes any and all national laws and regulations, whether civil, criminal, administrative, in any jurisdiction giving effect to that meaning including, but limited to, statutes and subordinate legislation, ordinances permits, common law, local laws, judgments, and any notices, orders, directions, instructions or decisions of any competent authority
- 2. Restricted Use. All Wireless Equipment and/or Software sold by Harris provides the Customer with a capability that is restricted and otherwise controlled under United States Code Title 18. Use of Equipment and/or software is strictly governed by applicable federal, state and local law associated with electronic surveillance. The Customers obligation to protect Equipment, Software and Services information includes, but not limited to, the names of specific products, pricing, technical and performance data. The customer shall not disclose, distribute, or disseminate any information regarding Customers purchase or use of Harris Equipment to the public in any manner including but not limited to: in press releases, in court documents and/or proceedings, internet, or during other public forums or proceedings.

The Customer warrants that it has legal authority to lawfully employ the Equipment and will do so only in such a manner and for such purposes. The Customer also warrants that it has obtained the regulsite coordination for the acquisition and use of the Equipment with the appropriate U.S. Government agencies. Harris assumes no liability for any use, misuse or improper use of the Equipment and makes no representations as to Equipment sultability for any specific application. Customer shall not transfer, sell or assign the Equipment and/or Software without the prior written consent of Harris. The customer shall not in any civil or criminal proceeding, use or provide any information concerning Harris Equipment and/or Software beyond the evidentiary results obtained through the use of Equipment and/or Software without the prior written consent of Harris. The Customer shall notify Harris if it receives a request pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act (5 U.S.C. section 552) or an equivalent state or local law, the civil or criminal discovery process, or other judicial, legislative, or administrative process to disclose information regarding Harris Equipment and/or Software.

- a. In the event that any of the Equipment or Software purchased under this Agreement is lost or stolen, the Customer shall contact the Harris Help Desk at 1-800-358-5297 within 3 business days. Customer shall provide the Part Number and Serial Number of the Equipment and/or Software and a summary of facts surrounding the incident. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in Harris not accepting future orders from the Customer.
- 3. Proposat/Quote Validity. Prices quoted are valid for 180 days from the date of Quote. After the expiration of the 180-day period, Harris may modify its prices or extend the validity period.
- 4. Acceptance Modification of Terms. The Agreement will be deemed accepted by Customer upon the first to occur of (i) Customer's issuance of the Purchase Order; or (ii) Harris' commencement of performance under the Agreement. In either such event any additional or different terms proposed by Customer are rejected unless expressly approved in writing by Harris. No communication from Customer that in any way differs from or adds to the Agreement, irrespective of whether or not Harris reasonably objects thereto, will be binding upon Harris unless such different or additional terms are agreed to in writing by both Harris and Customer.
- 5. Taxes. All prices quoted are exclusive of all applicable sales, use, excise, and other taxes, duties, fees, or charges. Unless evidence of valid tax exempt status and/or resale certificate is provided by Customer prior to shipment, Harris shall add and Customer shall pay all such applicable taxes or charges levied or imposed to the invoice for the Equipment, Software, and/or Services.
- 6. Shipping and Delivery. Unless otherwise stated in the Agreement, all prices and terms are F.O.B. Destination and include freight charges. Harris may ship Equipment in multiple lots and Customer agrees to accept such multiple shipments and pay for each lot in accordance with the payment terms set forth herein.
- 7. Title and Risk of Loss. Title to and risk of loss for Equipment and Software media sold under the Agreement will pass to Customer upon receipt of equipment.



8. Payment Terms.

- a. Payment for an invoice is due within 30 days from the date of the invoice. Late payment will accrue interest to the outstanding balance at the lower of (i) 1.5% per month, or (ii) the highest rate allowed by law.
- b. Domestic Purchase Orders (not including Maintenance Agreements) are for shipments of Equipment, Software and/or Services to be delivered or Services to be performed within the continental United States and Canada. Harris will submit an invoice within 30 days of the Date of Acceptance of an individual delivery of Equipment, Software or performance of Services as identified in the Purchase Orders.
- 9. Annual Maintenance Agreement. Upon expiration of the warranty period, Customer may execute a separate maintenance agreement with Harris for Equipment and/or Software. Such maintenance agreements are available for a percentage of the original Purchase Prices of the Equipment and/or Software. Annual maintenance agreements include:
 - a. Customer telephone support during normal business hours, excluding holidays (Monday through Friday, Eastern Time).
 - b. Additional 12-month warranty on Equipment, with respect to the Equipment Maintenance Agreement.
 - c. For Software Maintenance Agreements Harris will provide notification of and free access to Software upgrades as defined in the maintenance agreement.

10. Equipment Return Policy.

- a. Equipment Damaged in Shipment. Upon receipt of shipments, Customer should open and inspect all boxes immediately for possible freight damage. If damage is found, Customer must notify the delivery carrier within 48 hours and request an inspection from the freight carrier. After notifying the delivery carrier of damage, Customer will promptly contact Harris for further Instructions. Damaged Equipment may not be returned without Harris' prior authorization. For Equipment returned under this paragraph the Date of Acceptance shall be adjusted to reflect the date repaired or undamaged Equipment is received.
- b. Items Shipped in Error. If the Customer receives Equipment and/or Software in error, the Customer will promptly notify Harris and Harris will provide return instructions, pay shipping costs (provided Harris' instructions are followed) and provide a Return Material Authorization Customer will retain the Equipment's original packing material for use in return shipment to Harris.
- c. Defective Equipment. Equipment is provided with either Harris' standard equipment warranty or the manufacturer's standard equipment warranty. Upon discovery of a defect or other warranty-related problem, Customer shall promptly contact Harris for warranty support. Customer agrees not to return the Equipment until a service representative has issued an RMA, including a form which Customer must fill out describing the nature of the Equipment defect.

- d. Other Reasons. If Customer desires to return Equipment for other reasons. Customer must contact Harris for a RMA number. Harris' customer service representative will require a clear statement of the reason for the return request. Upon approval of Customer's request, an RMA will be issued. Customer will not return any Equipment without an RMA. Equipment being returned may be subject to restocking and other charges. CUSTOM MANUFACTURED OR SPECIAL ORDER ITEMS ARE NOT RETURNABLE.
- e. Upon Receipt of a Return Authorization. RMA numbers must appear on each individual package being returned. Customer is responsible for ensuring the safe return of Equipment for the full invoice amount and all shipping costs. Harris may refuse shipments of Equipment returned without a valid RMA number. All Equipment being returned for credit must be returned in a timely manner and in good condition. If Equipment shows evidence of damage, wear and tear, or if components or accessories are missing, then Harris at its sole judgment may reduce any credit agreed to prior to receipt of the Equipment.

11. Limited Warranty.

- a. Harris warrants the Equipment and Software ordered hereunder as of the Date of Acceptance to be substantially free from defects in material and workmanship. Harris' liability under this Limited Warranty will commence on the Date of Acceptance of the individual item of Equipment and Software and will terminate after 12 months. Written notice of any defects will be given to Harris upon discovery and Harris will promptly correct such defects by repair or replacement, at its option, without charge. Harris uses new and reconditioned parts to complete repairs and replacements under the terms of this warranty. Defective articles will not be returned to Harris without the prior written authorization of Harris. Call 1-800-358-5297 to obtain a Return Material Authorization (RMA) number. Harris will determine, in its sole discretion, existence and cause of the claimed defect. Specifically excluded from the terms of this Limited Warranty are any defects which occur as a result of:
 - Acts of God.
 - Physical impact, crash or foreign object damage.
 - Improper installation, use, maintenance, storage, modification or alteration by the Customer or its Customer.
 - The Customer's (or its customer's) operation of the Equipment delivered under this Agreement with any accessory, equipment or part not specifically approved by the Harris unless the Customer furnishes clear and convincing evidence that such accessory, equipment, or part was not a cause of the defect
 - Normal wear and tear. (The Customer recognizes that certain parts have a limited service life and will wear out through normal use).
 - Equipment or Software subjected to misuse, detrimental exposure or negligence.



- b. Harris is not responsible under this provision for defects with respect to items not provided by Harris or its subcontractors.
- c. For purposes of Harris' warranties for Equipment and Software media, a "defect" is defined as a failure of any unit or component manufactured or supplied by Harris that is not attributable to unauthorized modification or alteration, misuse or lack of care in operation, maintenance or handling. Customer's written notice of the defect must include a description of the defect with detailed information reasonably sufficient for Harris to identify the defect and determine its probable cause. Components or parts that Customer claims to be defective must be available to Harris for inspection and testing. Customer may not return defective Equipment, components or parts without first obtaining an RMA and instructions from Harris. Customer is solely responsible for U.S. Customs and Border Protection clearance or permissions for all replacement parts.
- d. CLAIMS UNDER ANY OF THE FOREGOING WARRANTIES ARE WAIVED UNLESS MADE WITHIN THE EQUIPMENT WARRANTY PERIOD IN THE CASE OF EQUIPMENT, OR WITHIN THE SOFTWARE WARRANTY PERIOD IN THE CASE OF SOFTWARE. NO PERSON IS AUTHORIZED TO GIVE ANY OTHER WARRANTIES OR TO ASSUME ANY OTHER LIABILITIES ON HARRIS' BEHALF, UNLESS MADE OR ASSUMED IN WRITING BY A DULY AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE OF HARRIS.
- e. HARRIS' LIABILITY FOR BREACH OF ANY OR ALL WARRANTIES FOR EQUIPMENT, SOFTWARE, SERVICES AND LICENSED HARRIS PROGRAMS IS EXPRESSLY LIMITED TO THE REPAIR, REPLACEMENT, OR REFUND OF THE PURCHASE PRICE OF SUCH DEFECTIVE EQUIPMENT OR SOFTWARE, LESS A REASONABLE CHARGE FOR USE. IN NO EVENT WILL HARRIS OR ITS LICENSORS BE LIABLE FOR ANY INDIRECT, SPECIAL, INCIDENTAL, PUNITIVE OR CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES BY REASON OF ANY BREACH OF WARRANTY OR DEFECT IN MATERIALS OR WORKMANSHIP. HARRIS WILL NOT BE REQUIRED TO REPAIR, REPLACE, OR REFUND THE PURCHASE PRICE OF EQUIPMENT OR SOFTWARE WHICH HAVE BEEN SUBJECTED TO NEGLECT, ACCIDENT, OR IMPROPER USE, OR WHICH HAVE BEEN ALTERED OTHER THAN BY AUTHORIZED HARRIS PERSONNEL.
- f. THIS WARRANTY CONSTITUTES HARRIS' SOLE AND EXCLUSIVE LIABILITY HEREUNDER AND CUSTOMER'S SOLE AND EXCLUSIVE REMEDY FOR DEFECTIVE OR NON-CONFORMING EQUIPMENT, SERVICES, SOFTWARE. THE FOREGOING WARRANTIES ARE IN LIEU OF ALL OTHER WARRANTIES (EXCEPT AS TO TITLE), WHETHER ORAL OR WRITTEN, EXPRESS OR IMPLIED, OR STATUTORY, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, ANY IMPLIED WARRANTY OR CONDITION OF MERCHANTABILITY, ANY IMPLIED WARRANTY OR CONDITION OF FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE, OR ANY WARRANTY OR CONDITION ARISING OUT OF COURSE OF DEALING, COURSE OF PERFORMANCE, OR CUSTOM OR USAGE OF TRADE. CUSTOMER AGREES THAT NO CIRCUMSTANCE CAUSING CUSTOMER EXCLUSIVE AND LIMITED REMEDIES TO FAIL IN THEIR ESSENTIAL PURPOSE WILL INCREASE OR EXTEND ANY HARRIS WARRANTY.

- 12. Repairs. To repair any Wireless products Equipment after the 12-month warranty has expired, Customer may call 1-800-358-5297 to obtain an RMA number and a quote for the estimated cost for repair.
 - a. Repair Policy. To affect a repair on a Wireless Product, the Equipment and/or Software should be returned to the Harris' factory with a written description of the failure mode. Out-of-warranty repairs apply to any Equipment and/or Software whose standard 12-month warranty has expired, no Maintenance Agreement has been purchased and paid for, and/or any Equipment and/or Software damaged in a manner not covered by the standard warranty, including any defects which occur as identified under 11.a above. Equipment and/or Software should not be returned to the Harris' factory without an RMA. Call 1-800-358-5297 to obtain an RMA number.
 - b. Support Policy. Harris provides free help desk support throughout the warranty period and Maintenance Agreement of purchased Equipment and/or Software. Technical support is available Monday through Friday, during normal business hours (Eastern Time) excluding holidays, via the help desk support center at 1-800-358-5297.

13. Software License.

- a. Subject to full payment of the Purchase Price by Customer, Harris grants to Customer a nontransferable (except as expressly provided herein), nonexclusive license to use the Software (software, firmware, and documentation) in connection with use of the Equipment purchased hereunder. The Software furnished with the Equipment will be of the latest generation available at the time of shipment of the Equipment. Harris is under no obligation to supply updates to the Software except where expressly agreed to by the parties in writing.
- b. This license is limited to object code programs and related documentation only and does not apply to any of the corresponding source code or program listings.
- c. Customer acknowledges that Harris (or its licensor) has valuable property rights in the Software, and the Software will continue to be the sole and exclusive property of Harris or its licensor. Customer will obtain no title or rights to the Software. All rights in patents, copyrights and trade secrets in relation to the Software will continue to be vested in Harris or its licensor.
- d. Customer will keep the Software confidential by affording access to the Software only to those of its employees, agents, or consultants having a need to know and having such individuals agree in writing to the obligations contained herein. In addition, Customer will employ its best efforts to prevent any unauthorized use, copying, publishing, reproducing, or disclosing of the Software and will treat the Software with the same care as its own confidential information.
- e. The Software may be used only in conjunction with the Equipment purchased hereunder. Customer may not rent, lease, transfer, network, display, or distribute the Software, nor may Customer reverse engineer, disassemble, decompile, modify, alter, translate, or adapt the Software or create any derivative thereof, except where expressly agreed to by the parties in writing



- f. Customer acknowledges that a violation of this Agreement would cause irreparable injury to Harris or its licensor, and that Harris or its licensor will be entitled, in addition to any other rights and remedies it may have, at law or in equity, to an injunction enjoining and restraining Customer from doing or continuing to do any such act and any other violations or threatened violations of this Agreement. Furthermore, Customer agrees that if Harris or its licensor should waive any breach of any provision of this Agreement, it will not thereby be deemed to have waived any preceding or succeeding breach of the same or any other provision of this Agreement. If Customer sells or otherwise disposes of Customer-owned media on which any Software is fixed, such media must be erased before any sale or disposal.
- 14. Availability Discontinued/Last Time Buy. Harris makes no representation about the continued availability of the Equipment and Software. Harris reserves the right, in its sole discretion, with or without notice, without incurring any liability to Customer or otherwise whether in contract or tort, to discontinue manufacturing or selling any Equipment and Software at any time or from time to time. Harris may within its sole discretion provide Customer with an opportunity to purchase such quantities of the Equipment or Software as Customer estimates it may need ("last time buy") within 30 days of Customer's receipt of notice from Harris. Customer's last time buy rights are limited to products available in Harris' inventory at the time of Customer's request. Harris will provide warranty services and make spare parts available to Customer for a period of one (1) year after notice by Harris to Customer that the Equipment has been discontinued or for a period of 90 days after notice to Customer that the Software has been discontinued.

15. Intellectual Property Indemnification.

- a. In the event any Equipment to be furnished under this Agreement is not to be made in accordance with drawings, samples or manufacturing specifications designated by Customer, but rather is the design of Harris, Harris agrees that it will, at its own expense and at its option, defend or settle any claim, suit, or proceeding brought against Customer or any customer of Customer, based on an allegation that the Equipment furnished under this Agreement constitutes a direct or a contributory infringement of any claim of any United States patent, mask work, copyright or any other intellectual property right. This obligation will be effective only if Customer will have made all payments then due and if Harris is notified promptly of said allegation in writing and given authority, information, and assistance for the settlement or defense of said claim, suit, or proceeding. Harris will pay all damages and costs assessed in such suit or proceedings. In the event of a final adjudication by a court of competent jurisdiction that the Equipment or any part thereof infringes or violates any third party intellectual property right or if the use or sale thereof is enjoined, or if the provisions of any negotiated settlement Agreement prohibit the use of the product, Harris will at its sole option and its own expense, either
 - Procure for Customer the right to continue using the Equipment;
 - Replace It with a substantially equivalent non-infringing equipment;
 - Modify it so it becomes non-infringing but substantially equivalent; or
 - iv. If none of the above is reasonably available, terminate the Customer's right to use the Equipment and return to the Customer a pro-rata portion of the price originally paid by Customer to Harris represented by the remaining useful life of the Equipment as a percentage of the total useful life

- b. The foregoing indemnity does not apply to the following:
 - Infringement by a combination of Equipment furnished under this Agreement with other equipment not furnished hereunder unless Harris is a contributory infringer;
 - ii. Infringement resulting from changes or modifications made to or from the Equipment by the Customer;
 - Any settlements of a claim, suit, or proceeding made without Harris' written consent; and
 - iv. Any Equipment to be furnished under this Agreement which is to be delivered to the United States Government.
- c. The foregoing states the entire liability of Harris with respect to infringement or violation of third party intellectual property rights in connection with Equipment furnished under this Agreement.
- d. In the event any Equipment to be furnished under this Agreement is to be made in accordance with drawings, samples or manufacturing specifications designated by Customer and is not the design of Harris, Customer will, to the fullest extent permitted by applicable law, defend and hold Harris harmless to the same extent and subject to the same requirements as set forth in (a) and (b) above. Should the Customer be the United States Government, the Customer agrees to incorporate FAR 52.227-1, Authorization and Consent, in any Purchase Order or Contract.

16. Technical Data and Inventions.

- a. Unless specifically agreed to by Harris and expressly identified and priced in the Agreement as a separate item or items to be delivered by Harris, the sale of Equipment, Software and Services under the Agreement confers on Customer no right in, license under, access to, or entitlement of any kind to any of Harris' technical data including, but not limited to design, process technology, software and drawings, or to any of Harris' inventions (whether or not patentable), irrespective of whether any such technical data or invention or any portion thereof arose out of work performed under or in connection with the Agreement, and irrespective of whether Customer has paid or is obligated to pay Harris for any part of the design or development of the Equipment, Software or Services.
- b. Harris will not be obliged to safeguard or hold confidential any data whether technical or otherwise, furnished by Customer for Harris' performance of the Agreement unless (and only to the extent that) Customer and Harris have entered into a separate written confidentiality agreement.
- Customer will not violate Harris' copyright of documents or Software or disclose Harris' confidential or proprietary data to others without Harris' written permission.
- d. All Inventions are and shall at all times remain Harris's confidential or proprietary information. All rights, title and interest in and to the Inventions, including all intellectual property rights, remain vested in Harris, its suppliers or licensors, subject only to the license grant below. "Inventions" shall mean and include all ideas, concepts, know-how, techniques, inventions, discoveries, improvements, specifications, designs, methods, devices, systems, reports, studies, computer software (in object or



source code), programming and other documentation, flow charts, diagrams and all other information or tangible material of any nature whatsoever (in any medium and in any stage of development or completion) included in or resulting from the work contemplated hereunder, that are conceived, designed, practiced, prepared, produced or developed by Harris or any of its personnel during the course of performance of any Work.

17. Excusable Delay.

- a. Harris will be excused from performance under the Agreement and will not be liable to Customer for delay in performance attributable, in whole or in part, to any cause beyond its reasonable control, including, but not limited to, actions or inactions of government whether in its sovereign or contractual capacity, judicial action, war, civil disturbance, insurrection, sabotage, act of public enemy or terrorism, labor difficulties, failure or delay in delivery by Harris' suppliers or subcontractors, transportation difficulties, shortage of energy, materials, labor or equipment, accident, fire, flood, storm or other act of nature, Customer's fault or negligence or where compliance with any applicable environmental law or regulation by Harris is not reasonably technologically or economically feasible, or would otherwise require Harris to change its manufacturing process.
- b. In the event of an excusable delay, Harris will make commercially reasonable efforts to notify Customer of the nature and extent of such delay and (1) Harris will be entitled to a schedule an extension on at least a day-for-day basis, and (2) if the delay is caused by Customer's fault or negligence, Harris will be entitled to an equitable adjustment in price under the Agreement.
- 18. Termination. Either party may terminate this Agreement if the other party defaults in a material respect under this Agreement and fails to cure such default within thirty (30) days after receiving written notice from the other party of such default. If Harris terminates this Agreement based on the Customer's breach, then Harris will be entitled to damages, including any lost profits Harris would have realized, had Harris been permitted to perform in accordance with the Agreement. Customer also will be liable for all costs to Harris resulting from Harris' attempt to enforce its rights hereunder, including, but not limited to collection agency fees, attorney fees, court costs, etc.

19. Export and Re-Export Restrictions.

a. Customer acknowledges that the Equipment and Software sold or licensed to it by Harris under this Agreement may be subject to export controls under the laws of the United States or Canada. Customer will not export or re-export the Equipment or Software, technology, or products manufactured from the technology that are the subject of the Agreement in violation of the export control laws of the United States or Canada. Customer will, to the fullest extent permitted by applicable law defend and hold Harris harmless from and against any loss, damage, or liability arising out of Customer's failure to comply with this Section 19. The Customer will supply to the Harris on a timely basis all necessary information and documentation requested by Harris in order to permit the Harris to export the Equipment, Software and/or Services with respect to any Purchase Order issued by the Customer hereunder, in accordance with the terms of this Agreement.

- b. Hello Johanna.

We haven't spoken in a while so I wanted to provide you with a quick recap of the events of the last several months. We previously submitted a funding request through the port to buy/build all that time, and at the suggestion of the manufacturer (Harris WPG) we listed the company Future Concepts as the integrator suited to build/install equipment from Harris WPG. At the time we submitted our funding request, Future Concepts was the only integrator on the west coast Harris WPG recommended. However, after we received notice that our request was approved for funding. Harris no longer recommends Future Concepts, and now recommends doing one of two thing: use their east coast integrator or have Harris do the integration directly but at an increased cost. Well there are pros and cons to each approach, most of which we discussed.

I've put together a list of the vendor quotes so you can look at them and provide us with your feedback and path forward to get this platform funded and into contract. Once everything is signed and purchase orders are in place, the build will take approximately 6 months. Needles to say, we'd really like to get it moving.

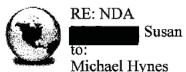

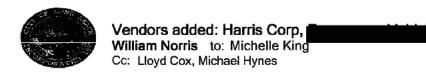

Affiant declares under penalty of perjury that the following facts are true and that there is probable cause to believe, and Affiant does believe, that the requested information and services for the Target Telephone Number(s) are now in the described locations:

SUMMARY OF INVESTIGATION

Based on the aforementioned information, I believe probable cause exists to examine the account associated with the Target Telephone Number(s) for subscriber information, call detail records with cellular site information, GPS location information, and a pen register/trap-and-trace. Based on my training and experience, I believe utilizing this information, in conjunction with traditional investigative techniques, may greatly assist in this investigation and help law enforcement locate and apprehend the outstanding suspect(s). The following explains how the information and services requested herein will assist in this investigation:

 Subscriber information for the Target Telephone Number(s) and phones contacted by the Target Telephone Number(s) during the period of time authorized by the Search Warrant will provide me with

the cellular device's registered owner's name, address, device serial number, and activation/deactivation date. This basic information will aid in identifying the subscriber of the Target Telephone Number(s) as well as what type of cellular device is associated with the account (i.e. serial number and other network related numbers). The subscriber information of other phones communicating with the Target Telephone Number(s) is vital in the identification of coconspirators and associates of the suspect(s). By identifying the users of the phones contacted by the Target Telephone Number(s), in conjunction with traditional investigative techniques, law enforcement will be able to utilize this information to locate and arrest the suspect(s).

- Call detail records with cellular site information will tend to show telephone numbers that the Target Telephone(s) has communicated with before, during, and after the crime as well as basic cellular tower location information which can range up to 20 miles, depending on the environment. This information will aid with identifying the whereabouts and identity, if unknown, of the suspect(s). Call detail records with cellular tower location information of telephone numbers the Target Telephone Number(s) has contacted will tend to identify other co-conspirators, additional suspects, friends, family, and/or accessories involved in the case. It is important to identify the telephone numbers most commonly contacted by the Target Telephone Number(s) because this information may assist law enforcement locate and apprehend the suspect(s). Based on my training and experience, I have learned that suspect(s) often call friends, family, or co-conspirators to ask for assistance with money, a place to hide, or to receive other forms of charity that will allow them to avoid detection by law enforcement. I have personally worked multiple cases in the past where a suspect has called a friend or family member before traveling to their residence to hide. Once the suspect arrived at the location, they shut their cellular phone off and began using a new cellular phone provided by their family or friend. In these cases, the only way I was able to locate and arrest the suspect was identifying the most commonly called telephone numbers as well as the last telephone number the suspect called.
- The installation of a pen register/trap and trace device with cellular tower information will provide law enforcement with basic real time information pertaining to the Target Telephone Number(s), such as: date/time of call, duration, outgoing telephone number, incoming telephone number, and cellular site/sector. This is very basic information that does not provide any call content (law enforcement cannot hear any voice communication or see the content of text messages). Although this is basic information, it may assist law enforcement identify a general location where the suspect may be hiding and/or help identify coconspirators or other persons who may be relevant to this investigation that could be assisting the suspect(s). According to Smith vs. Maryland, 442 U.S. 735 (1979), the United States Supreme Court used an analogy and compared a pen register/trap-and-trace to an un-opened piece of mail: any person can see who an envelope was addressed to and who it was from, however, they cannot see the "content" contained inside the envelope unless they open it. The US Supreme Court ruled that a pen register/trap-and-trace is not a search and does not fall under the Fourth Amendment; therefore, a search warrant is not required because we can only see the incoming and outgoing telephone numbers, we cannot hear any conversations or see any text messages which would be considered "content". If law enforcement were to request "content", this information would fall under the Title III Wiretap category which is a completely different process and is NOT being requested in this case.

• GPS Precision Location Information will enable law enforcement to locate the Target Telephone(s) with a higher degree of certainty than a pen register/trap-and-trace. There are a lot of variables with the accuracy of GPS and some Service Providers do not offer this feature for law enforcement. Therefore, it is imperative to utilize traditional investigative techniques, call detail records, pen register/trap-and-trace data, and GPS in order to locate the suspect(s). Third Party GPS Precision Location Information enables law enforcement to identify the user of phones being contacted by or contacting the Target Telephone(s). Since modern cellular phones can be purchased without the use of identification, Service Providers typically do not have any subscriber information on file identifying the user of the phone.

Based on my training and experience as an Detective, I know suspects/fugitives usually maintain contact with family members, friends, boyfriends/girlfriends, other criminal associates, and other individuals who can assist him/her elude law enforcement in order to avoid being arrested. These individuals can advise the fugitive of police inquiries, provide monetary assistance, as well as other types of aid. The use of a cellular phone is likely the primary means a suspect/fugitive can maintain contact with those aiding and abetting their fugitive status. By doing so, the suspect/fugitive's cellular telephone records, GPS location information, and data collected during a pen register/trap-and-trace, may furnish evidence that tends to show a conspiracy to obstruct justice has occurred (violation of 182(5) PC). Furthermore, this information may also tend to identify persons who have been harboring, concealing, or aiding the fugitive (violation of 32 PC) who may help law enforcement locate and arrest the fugitive as well as any other co-conspirators involved in the case.

SEALING ORDER / SERVICE OF WARRANT

Good cause appearing herein, I request that the Affidavit in Support of Search Warrant, the attached and incorporated Statement of Probable Cause, Search Warrant, and Return to Search warrant, be sealed. Sealing Order: Pending further order of the court, this Search Warrant and all accompanying documents shall not become a public record and shall be sealed and maintained in the custody of the Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department in a secure location, accessible to only supervisory personnel. Grounds for sealing:

Official Information (Ca. Evidence Code § 1040)

These documents shall not be made a public record until further order of this Court. This Court finds it is necessary to seal these documents in order to implement the official information privilege pursuant to Evidence Code sections 1040 to 1042 to preserve the confidentiality of official information. This Court further finds that disclosure of the information contained in these documents is against the public interest because there is a necessity for preserving the confidentiality of official information that outweighs the necessity for disclosure. Accordingly, I request this Court grant this Sealing Order to implement the privilege pursuant to California Evidence Code sections 1040 to 1042 to protect official information.

In granting this Sealing Order this Court finds that: (1) there exists an overriding interest that overcomes the right of public access to the records of this Search Warrant; (2) the overriding interest supports sealing the records of this Search Warrant; (3) a substantial probability exists that the overriding interest will be prejudiced

if the records of this Search Warrant are not sealed; (4) the proposed sealing is narrowly tailored considering the facts and basis for the issuance of this Search Warrant; and (5) no less restrictive means exist to achieve the overriding interest.

Based on my training and experience, I know that suspects are constantly trying to identify law enforcement electronic surveillance techniques and how that information is used locate and apprehend them. While criminals have knowledge that law enforcement use information obtained from cell phone companies in their investigations, they are often unaware of the scope and circumstances in which law enforcement does request Affidavits in Support of Search Warrants to obtain this type of information. These criminals are also typically unaware in the ways law enforcement utilizes this information to apprehend them and discover their criminal conduct. Because of this lack of knowledge, suspects often retain and use cell phones to facilitate crimes, coordinate with coconspirators, contact associates, and engage in other activities. Since criminals are generally unaware of these law enforcement techniques, it is in the best interest of the public that these investigative techniques are preserved and kept confidential.

Based on my training and experience, it is common practice for criminals to discuss with one another investigative techniques used by law enforcement to apprehend them. Criminals will often work together to discover and develop ways to thwart law enforcement techniques used to apprehend them. For example, I have seen and learned of various anti-law enforcement techniques that have been developed and passed on to large populations of criminals such as counter surveillance techniques, fleeing pursuit techniques, covert/coded communication, anti-interception of cell phone communication techniques, and counter arrest and control techniques. If the techniques used in this investigation were to be divulged, it would seriously jeopardize the ability to utilize the same or similar techniques for other serious investigations such as, apprehending murder suspects, terrorists, rapists, kidnaping suspects, and child molest suspects. Furthermore, law enforcement often attempts to arrest the same suspect for new and/or repeat criminal conduct. I have personally arrested many suspects over the years that are repeat offenders and/or considered career criminals. Therefore, it would be foolish for law enforcement to divulge our electronic surveillance techniques to wanted suspects because this information would seriously jeopardize future investigations and essentially alert the suspect and his/her friends on how to circumvent our techniques. information requested herein is being utilized to locate and apprehend the suspect, not as additional evidence in a criminal case. For these reasons California Evidence Code § 1040 allows law enforcement not to disclose their investigative techniques when the need for disclosure is outweighed by society's need to preserve confidentiality. If criminals were to learn of these investigative techniques they would be able to easily combat them by developing various methods to thwart law enforcement, such as discarding cell phones at a much higher rate or developing other techniques to avoid GPS and pen register/trap-and-trace data.

In the past, when officers invoked their right to retain their investigative techniques under California Evidence

Code § 1040 in relation to a surveillance location, the Court of Appeal agreed to keep the information confidential in their finding in People v. Walker (1991) 230 Cal.App.3d 230, 235-8. The concept of protecting surveillance locations finds strong support in an analogy to the confidential informer privilege. According to a quote from United States v. Green (D.C. Cir. 1981) 670 F.2d 1148, 1155, "Like confidential informants, hidden observation posts may often prove to be useful law enforcement tools, so long as they remain secret. Just as the disclosure of an informer's identity may destroy his [or her] future usefulness in criminal investigations, the identification of a hidden observation post will likely destroy the future value of that location for police surveillance. The revelation of a surveillance location might also threaten the safety of police officers using the observation post, or lead to adversity for cooperative owners or occupants of the building. Finally, the assurance of nondisclosure of a surveillance location may be necessary to encourage property owners or occupants to allow the police to make such use of their property."

It is important to note that, pursuant to California Penal Code 1524(a)(12), the objective for obtaining the information requested herein is specifically for "Locating an individual who has committed or is committing a felony," and <u>not</u> for obtaining additional material evidence that will be used to prosecute the suspect. Therefore, the information obtained with this search warrant is not necessarily connected to the establishment of the suspect's guilt, and it is not anticipated this information will be used in any judicial hearing against the suspect(s). Essentially, the information requested herein will be utilized in conjunction with traditional investigative techniques to locate and apprehend the suspect(s). Hence the need for disclosure to the suspects is of lesser value, People v. Montgomery (1988). If it is discovered at any time that the information obtained through this search warrant is of material value to the prosecution or the defense of the accused, the Court will be notified prior to the commencement of criminal proceedings so that this warrant will be unsealed and disclosed.

Based on my training and experience, I know that utilizing cellular technology to locate and apprehend suspects is non-intrusive when compared to executing a search warrant at a person's home or place of business because the information transmitted to and from the cellular device travels through a third party, namely the Service Provider. People are generally aware of this fact and know that their communications can be intercepted by not only law enforcement, but by other tech savvy criminals. This theory has proven to be reliable because, based on my training and experience, I know that suspects often change cellular phones to avoid detection by law enforcement. I have personally seen criminals change phones on a daily basis. The information requested within this search warrant is also very limited, since it does not allow law enforcement to receive the content of any cell phone communication (content can only be intercepted when a Title III Wire Tap is authorized which does not apply in this case). Law enforcement only receives limited GPS information at 15 minute intervals (depending on the Service Provider), the date/time of the calls, the telephone numbers calling the suspect or telephone numbers the suspect is calling, and the location of the cellular tower the suspect's cellular phone is registering with. The United States Supreme Court agreed in their finding in Smith vs.

Maryland, 442 U.S. 735 (1979) where they found that the installation and use of the pen register was not a "search" within the meaning of the Fourth Amendment, therefore, no warrant was required.

NIGHT SEARCH REQUEST

I request night service be authorized allowing service of the Search Warrant to Service Provider Subpoena Compliance at any time, day or night, within ten days of issuance. Based on my training and experience, I know that Service Provider has Law Enforcement Compliance Analysts on duty 24 hours a days, 7 days a week to process requests. I frequently send Search Warrants over to the telecommunication companies via email or FAX after midnight for billing purposes if I know that I will not be able to monitor the PEN register/trapand-trace and/or GPS location information until the following day. Over the years, I have learned that utilizing this method serves two important functions: 1. It reduces unnecessary costs because Service Provider can charge up to \$100.00 per day for their services, 2. Our request will be processed quicker because it will be at the top of Service Provider's list for that particular day. Moreover, the authorization of night service is no more intrusive than serving Service Provider during business hours because this request will be sent via e-mail or FAX to their Subpoena Compliance Unit; I will not be making entry into a business or any other structure to serve this Search Warrant. I also request permission to monitor the pen register/trap-and-trace as well as GPS precision location information at any time, day or night, for the thirty (30) day time period covered by this Search Warrant. Furthermore, I request law enforcement officers and agents have permission to pause or stop activation and/or monitoring of the pen register/trap-and trace and/or GPS precision location information at any time during the thirty day period covered by this Search Warrant and may resume activation and/or monitoring without further order from this Court, so as long as the activation and/or monitoring is resumed during the thirty day period authorized by this Search Warrant.

CONCLUSION

During a majority of the investigations that I have participated in over the past several years, I have seen a steady rise in the usage of cellular phones by criminals. Based on my experiences, it is commonplace for criminals to have cellular phones; it is rare when I locate a criminal who does not have a cellular phone. In this digital era, even criminals regularly use the internet, cellular phones, or other telecommunications devices to communicate via voice, text message, peer to peer messaging, and/or social networking sites such as MySpace, Facebook, Twitter, etc. In many cases, utilizing these methods of communication offers a discrete and/or completely anonymous way of keeping in contact with people anywhere in the world at any given time.

When any person makes or receives a phone call on their cellular phone, the following information for each call is stored by their respective phone company for at least one year: date, time, duration, phone number dialed or received numbers (even if caller identification is blocked by the calling party), text message transaction data, IP packet data session logs, and cellular tower location/sector at the beginning and ending of the call/data session. This is very basic information and does not provide an exact location of the person nor does it identify

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the other party. Cellular towers are strategically placed throughout the world by phone companies in an attempt to provide a seamless operation so people can travel virtually anywhere and make or receive a call. A typical cellular phone tower will be mounted up high on a large pole, building, or other structure which provides an unobstructed view of the population below. Cellular towers are divided into sectors, depending on the cellular provider. Each individual sector is mounted on the tower and faces a specific direction to provide maximum cellular coverage for the people in the area. The range of the tower depends on environmental factors and whether it is located in a highly populated urban environment or desolate rural area. Cellular towers do not provide an exact location of the suspect; they can only provide the physical location of the tower itself and a direction from the tower which can cover an area anywhere from 0-20 miles.

Some cellular companies offer GPS capabilities and/or cellular tower triangulation to law enforcement after receiving a Search Warrant, while other cellular companies do not offer either of these services and can only provide cellular tower locations. Utilizing GPS and/or cellular tower triangulation gives a much smaller area to search and greatly increases the likelihood that law enforcement will be able to locate the suspect. Cellular companies typically provide GPS and/or cellular tower triangulation at fifteen minute intervals, not on a real time basis. Indeed, this location information is beneficial and definitely helps law enforcement get into an area where the suspect may be; however, traditional investigative techniques are still required to locate the suspect's exact location. Often times the suspect may be hiding with family or friends, which may fall within the area of the GPS and/or cellular tower triangulation. There have been times when I was unable to find the suspect; however, his/her vehicle was located within the area of the GPS and/or cellular tower triangulation. In these situations, I conducted surveillance on the vehicle until the suspect returned. Unfortunately, there have also been times when I was unable to locate a suspect even after utilizing GPS and/or cellular tower triangulation. At the conclusion of past investigations, after the suspect was arrested, I learned the suspect was in close proximity to the GPS radius but not within the specific area given by the Service Provider.

I am aware that criminals commonly change their phone numbers, or purchase new phones, in order to defeat surveillance by law enforcement. Pre-paid cellular phones, otherwise known as "disposable phones" or "burner phones" are easily purchased at nearly any local supermarket or convenient store, such as 7-11 or Circle K. Pre-paid phones offer people the opportunity to purchase a cellular phone anonymously without having to fill out any application or complete a credit check, which allows anyone to use a false name and/or on their account. The cost for a pre-paid phone is rather cheap and costs anywhere between \$30-\$50 per month for unlimited talk, text, and internet usage.

The ease of being able to purchase a pre-paid phone has caused law enforcement a lot of problems when attempting to locate wanted felons because it becomes very difficult, sometimes impossible, to determine the identity of a subscriber when they list a false name, such as "Mickey Mouse" or "John Doe", on their pre-paid cellular phone account. I have personally encountered these false names as well as many other false names

during past investigations. It seems to be a growing trend for suspects to list false names, or even no names, on their pre-paid cellular phone accounts.
Based upon the aforementioned facts and circumstances, I have reasonable cause to believe that grounds for the issuance of a Search Warrant exist, as set forth in Section 1524 of the California Penal Code as well as 18 USC § 2703(c), 2703(d), 3122, and 3123). I pray that a Search Warrant be issued based upon the aforementioned facts, for the seizure of said property, or any part thereof, good cause being shown thereof, and the same be brought before this Magistrate or retained subject to the order of the court, or of any court in which the offense(s) in respect to which the property of things taken, triable, pursuant to Section 1536 of the Penal Code.
